MINUTES OF THE 25th ACADEMIC COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON 17th MARCH 2018

The 25th Academic Council meeting of Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth was held on 17th March 2018, at the Board Room, Administrative Block of Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth, under the Chairmanship of the Vice-Chancellor, Prof.K.R.Sethuraman, at 2.00 pm.

The Vice-Chancellor welcomed the members of the Academic Council of SBV .The Vice-Chancellor welcomed and acknowledged the esteemed presence of the external members, Prof. S.P. Thyagarajan, Prof. Thomas V Chacko and Prof.G.Subramanian, while thanking them for attending the 25th Academic Council meet.

Prof. S.P. Thyagarajan in his opening remarks thanked the Chancellor and the Vice-Chancellor for having accorded membership in the Academic Council of SBV. He complimented that the deliberations at the Academic Council meetings of SBV are of high standards signifying rich tradition and ethos, quality discussion and enhancement. As a corollary to the compliment, there is an immediate requirement to understand the importance and implications of proper documentation which has become a virtual necessity to stake our position in statutory councils, NAAC, NIRF, NABH and others. As per the revised criteria of NAAC, health sciences institution would be subjected to stringent assessment and a special manual highlighting this purpose will be released by NAAC in May 2018. Accordingly, the Quantitative and Qualitative aspects would assume relevance as per the gradation. The NAAC Peer team will assess only 30% (Qualitative aspects) and the rest 70% (Quantitative) will be evaluated based on sound documentation. The documentation needs to be effected at each of the departments and finally consolidated by the IQAC, in addition to the fact that documentation is a continuous process. He also lauded the initiative of SBV signing a MoU with INFLIBNET, an UGC initiative to upload the Postgraduate, Super specialty, M.Phil and PhD dissertations/ thesis.

Prof. G. Subramaniam reiterated that in the 10th year of existence, SBV has entered into the Log phase from Lag phase. Every department should bring to light even minor pertinent details including work force requirement, resources, output, etc. He further added that more scope and weight age should be added in the arena of research and consultancy, besides academics and patient care.


