

MINUTES OF THE FIFTH MEETING OF THE SBV COUNCIL

The fifth meeting of the SBV Council was held on **22nd August 2018**, Wednesday at **2.15 pm** in the SBV Board Room under the Chairmanship of Prof.N.Ananthakrishnan, Dean of Faculty, SBV.

After detailed discussion the following decisions were taken with respect to various agenda items as given below

 To nominate two medical faculty from SBV and one from medical faculty of another Indian University to the Governing Body of the Indian Council of Medical Research for a period of 3 years as requested by Association of Indian Universities (AIU) vide its letter Meet/ ICMR/ 2018 dated 30/07/2018.

It was unanimously resolved to nominate the Vice-Chancellor, Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth (Prof.S.C.Parija) and Director CIDRF (Prof Adithan C.) from Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth and Col.Dr.A.Ravikumar Dean (Education) SRMC from outside the university.

2. To deliberate on the request submitted by Ms. Bhuvaneshwari Ramesh, Tutor for the post of Lecturership in Music Therapy, it is opined by Registry that the request can be considered after the candidate completes two years at SBV from the completion of M.Sc Music Therapy programme.

Since Ms.Bhuvaneshwari Ramesh is pursuing part time PhD, she is advised to wait till she submits her synopsis before being considered for redesignation as lecturer. To deliberate and decide upon the candidature of Dr. Santosh Reddy K (UIN: 1501091010), MD – General Medicine to rejoin the course after 891 days of break, upon payment of requisite fees and consider the period of absence as deferment.

Dr. Santosh Reddy may join the course after payment od all arrears of fees, as listed by the account section. He will then put up the required attendance, as per MCI norms before being allowed to appear for the final examination.

4. To deliberate upon the proposal of conducting International Health Research Convention 2019 by SBV during July 2019.

The proposal for conducting the International Health Research Convention 2019 by SBV was placed before the Council by the Registrar who presented the overall layout of the Convention. While approving the proposal, the members insisted that the Committees for various events have to be constituted giving equal importance to all cadres from all the constituent colleges of SBV.

5. Inclusion of additional material for course work pertaining to Ph.D in Nursing sciences, in compliance with the directives of INC consortium.

Since this is not mandatory and falls outside the Ph.D Regulations of UGC, it was not accepted.

6. To examine the probability of upholding the deferment of M.Phil programme, of Dr. Niranjan, former professor and Head in-charge, department of Biochemistry, MGMCRI by 6 months vide requisition from Dr. G. Niranjan through communication, namely MGMCRI/Biochem/2018/350 dt. 31.07.2018.

The duration of the M.Phil has already been notified for Health Professions Education (HPE) as two years and extendable to four years, Dr. Niranjan who has completed only two years can complete the requirement for M.Phil in the remaining available time of two years; therefor, he need not be considered for deferment.

 To consider the reduction in the scale of punishment inflicted on Mr. Praveen Kumar V, II MBBS (1501001062) of MGMCRI as forwarded by the Dean – MGMCRI dated 20/08/2018.

Not acceded to, since the malpractice at the examination was proved, based on the findings and report of the duly convened committee following enquiry.

8. To deliberate on the policy for nomination to awards by private organisations in connection to the recent communication from Marina Labs, Chennai for Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam award for Teaching/Scientific excellence for the year 2012.

Matter to be discussed with Chancellor for uniform policy in this regard.

9. To deliberate on the provision for creating funds as well as relief teams to help the people of Kerala reeling under the recent flood / landslide disaster.

Since individuals have already contributed for relief from the Deemed university to various NGOs', there is no need to have a uniform policy for SBV. Further, the Medical Superintendent also apprised the SBV Council that offer of the Medical help has already been turned down by them. Meanwhile as individuals all staff can continue to contribute their mite for rehabilitation of this National Calamity.

10. To restructure the format for obtaining the Concurrence from the External Evaluators for Evaluating the M.Phil. / PhD Synopsis.

The new evaluation form for M.Phil/Ph.D synopsis have been approved and will be placed before AC for noting.

11. For noting - The B.Sc Medical Imaging Technology course of Mahatma Gandhi Medical College & Research Institute offered under the faculty of Allied Health Sciences is recognized by Atomic Energy Regulatory Board (AERB) and acceded into the list of approved diagnostic X- Ray Technologist courses in India in line with AERB requirement.

A letter would be sent by the Registrar to department of Radiodiagnosis, HoD, congratulating for the efforts in this regard. The head, Radiodiagnosis of Sri Sathya Sai Medical College and Research Institute(SSSMCRI) is also advised to initiate the same for B.Sc in Medical Imaging Technology course at SSSMCRI.

International Health Research Convention 2019-REPORT

The first International Health Research Convention 2019 (IHRC 2019) was held from 19th to 21st July 2019 involving the 4 constituent colleges and centers of Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth (SBV), Deemed-to-be-University, namely Mahatma Gandhi Medical College and Research Institute, Puducherry, Indira Gandhi Institute of Dental Sciences, Puducherry, Kasturba Nursing College, Puducherry, and Sri Sathya Sai Medical College and Research Institute, Kanchipuram and CIDRF (Central Interdisciplinary Research Facility), CYTER (Centre for Yoga Therapy Education and Research) and CMTER (Center for Music Therapy Education and Research). An international conference such of this involving all the aspects of healthcare and research of this magnitude has never happened in South India till date.

The main focus was on Academics, Health care and Research.
