# August 2019

As a measure of appreciation for those institutions and departments who excelled in their Administrative and Academic Audit performances for the year 2018, IQAC used a scoring system to rank them and the best performing institution, department, administrator and teaching faculty were awarded in the *SBV Founders' day 2019, on 4th August 2019*. Kasturba Gandhi Nursing College won the best performing institution award, Anaesthesiology department of MGMCRI, won the best performing department award, Ms. Asha Suresh Babu, GM, Administration won the best administrator award and Dr. M. Senthil, Professor and Head Public health dentistry, IGIDS, won the best performing faculty award for contribution to patents and copyrights.



IQAC was advised by the Vice-Chancellor, to constitute a NAAC team 2020, consisting of a human pyramid structure, where, all the seven criteria in the NAAC manual will be led by the criteria leaders, 35 key indicators will be supervised by the Steering members and 125 metrics will be complied by the task force members. The teams have been provided with road maps and deadlines for a systematic functioning. IQAC internal members and the NAAC team meeting was held under the chairmanship of the Vice- Chancellor.

# September 2019

- Submission of compliance of Strategic Perspective Plan SBV (including SPP-IQAC), AAA report, Feedback analysis and AQAR for the year 18-19 to BOM.
- IQAC in collaboration with the Registrar, MR. Srinivasan and SBV Chronicle Chief Editor, Dr. A.N. Uma, compiled the Annual Convocation Report, which



was presented by the Vice-Chancellor in the auspicious event of SBV Convocation 2019, on 5th September 2019.

- The Institution Innovation Council of SBV was registered under the MHRD, (IC 201912670), in September 2019, through the initiation of IQAC and handed over to the MIPTECH committee of SBV, to enhance the innovations, patents and discoveries.
- On 12th September 2019, the SBV student Support Cell was established in the Library 2nd floor and was inaugurated by the Vice-Chancellor. The informal function was attended by the Dean MGMCRI, Principal, IGIDS and other Faculty of SBV. This cell governs and monitors all student support and grievance redressal cells of the constituent colleges of SBV; the premises to be used by all the institutions on rotation.
- To streamline the consultancy provided by SBV, IQAC played a pivotal role in drafting the SBV Consultancy policy as well as in the formation of a Consultancy cell in September 2019.
- IQAC was instrumental in compiling the prospectus for the credit-based Interdisciplinary value-added certificate courses and Fellowship programs along with the Registry. A master calendar was also prepared and published in the website, for the conduct of the Faculty Development Programs and the Value-added courses.
- A FDP, on *e-content development* was organised by IQAC along with the Medical Informatics department to train the dental and nursing faculty on Learning Management Systems (LMS) on September 26th to 27<sup>th</sup> 2019. The sessions were done by Dr. Jagan Mohan R, Head, Medical Informatics and Dr. Richa Gupta from Department of Physiology, MGMCRI. 14 teachers from dental and nursing discipline benefitted out of this hands-on workshop.

# October 2019

 Quarterly Evaluative Review (July - September 19-20) meeting was conducted for the constituent units and centres. It was chaired by the Vice-chancellor. The departmental evaluative report form was modified based on the revised



Health Sciences manual and the departments, after their presentation submitted their data as e-copies into a dedicated cloud server (NextCloud), which is a green initiative of IQAC, towards a paperless office.

- IQAC commemorated the birth anniversaries of the great leaders of India, Mahatma Gandhi and Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam, on the 2<sup>nd</sup> October and 15<sup>th</sup> October respectively as a Quality Initiative to inculcate the sense of value and patriotism. IQAC conducted online contests- A photography contest was done on the theme of cleanliness as directed by the UGC to commemorate the 150th birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi. The contest was named as "Cleanscapes". MHRD, Govt. of India had announced the birth anniversary of Dr. APJ Kalam, as Innovation Day and to commemorate the same, Slogan and poster competition on "Innovation in Health Sciences" were conducted.
- Photographic external experts Mr. Ilangovan, Puducherry, Mr. Arvind Akki, Photographer of Aurobindo Ashram were the judges for the photo contest. Dr. Gunashekaran, Paediatrician ,JIPMER and Dr. Hanifa, MGMCRI, judged theeposter and e-slogans. As a part of green initiative, IQAC used google forms to conduct this contest. The judgement was also done online. The online contest was held from 3<sup>rd</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> October 2019. The judges were honoured with an eco-friendly bird feed box.
- An internal Quality orientation program was conducted on the topic *"Ishikawa Diagram - The Cause-and-Effect analysis",* delivered by Prof. K. Renuka, Principal, KGNC, SBV on 5<sup>th</sup> October 2019.
- A Faculty Development was conducted by IQAC on 21<sup>st</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> of October 2019. This workshop, titled as *"A Quality Initiative on Curriculum Mapping"* was attended by 30 senior level faculty from MGMCRI, SSSMCRI, KGNC and IGIDS, SBV. The resource personnel were from Rajiv Gandhi College of Engineering and Technology led by the Principal, Dr. E Vijayakrishan Rapaka. The participants' feedback elicited excellent understanding and usefulness of the session. E certificates with 4 SBV credit point were issued to the participants.

# June 2020

There were 95 registrations from Puducherry, Tamilnadu and international participants form Saudi Arabia.
- This Faculty Development Program(FDP) "Medical Laboratory- Internal Audit and Quality Management System as Per ISO 15189" was organized by Department of Pathology SSSMCRI in association with Centre for Health Professions Education(CHPE). from 3<sup>rd</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> June 2020. The target audience were Medical faculties of Pathology, Microbiology and Biochemistry Department. Technicians of the respective departments.



 Faculty Development Program (FDP) was jointly organized by Department of Microbiology, Hospital Infection Control Committee and Centre of Health professional education (CHPE), MGMCRI. Dr. R. Kalaivani, HICC Member Secretary and Professor, Department of Microbiology, MGMCRI was the Organizing Coordinator for this FDP event. Dr. M. V. Pravin Charles, Prof. Dept of Microbiology, MGMCRI was the Organizing Co-Coordinator for this event. The Title of the FDP was "Biohazard, Biomedical waste management and Laboratory Bio safety". The target audiences were Faculty, Residents, PhD scholars, Healthcare Workers.



- The Medical Education Unit of Shri Sathya Sai Medical College and research Institute organized these hands-on Webinar workshop on Application of technology for implementation of Competency based medical education as part of the National level FDPs being organized in collaboration with Center for Health. Professional Education (CHPE) on 4<sup>th</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> June 2020. The workshop consisted of 6 hours of online webinars and demonstration by resource persons over two days. Seven the resource persons were national faculty and six of the resource persons were in house faculty. This was followed up with 18 hours of offline assessments and tasks including a pretest and post-test, feedback forms, resource material, Reflective writing exercises and WhatsApp group discussions over three days, A total 273 delegates participated and completed all the assessments over three days. 
